

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE® (IB) CREDIT for 2007 Exams

In February 1990, the Academic Senate at Cal Poly adopted a credit policy regarding the IB Program:

1. The IB Diploma shall be considered in lieu of a high school diploma for admission to the University.
2. **Higher Level IB Exams** are passed by earning a grade of 5, 6 or 7.
3. Exams passed will earn course credit and/or elective units for a **maximum** of 8 units per exam.
4. Passed exams earn a Credit (CR) grade and are not calculated in the GPA.
5. Standard Level IB Exams are non-baccalaureate level and do not earn degree credit.
