- 2. Credit will be awarded for classes at the Higher level.
- For each exam score of 5 or higher, a maximum of 8 units of <u>elective credit</u> shall be awarded. 3.
- Course-specific credit may be granted with the concurrence of the academic department.
- All credit is given on a credit/no credit basis; units do not calculate in the GPA.
